On March 23-24, I attended the fifth annual Northeast Ohio Electric Festival, aka NEF. The facility, the Akron University field house, is huge. It houses a football field and a running track. The ceiling is high and well-lit, making it an ideal place to fly during the winter months.

I have attended every one of these events and this year, attendance was off. The contest director (CD), Tony Husak, indicated that in 2017, the event had nearly 200 pilots. In 2018, the pilot count was about 120. The weather was cold and conducive to indoor flying, and this event is the only major indoor flying event in District III.

Many people, me included, look forward to NEF because we do not have a local facility to fly indoors. However, I have observed that many clubs have found smaller nearby facilities that will accommodate indoor RC.

The event organizers have competitive events including musical airplanes, micro carrier landing, full contact combat, and more, creating a fun atmosphere.

Another highlight was the return of indoor Aerobatics or Pattern flying, known as F3P. If you have never seen this type of flying, you are really missing something. These aircraft are extremely lightweight and perform challenging pattern maneuvers that are typically flown with larger, 2-meter outdoor Pattern models.

The aircraft have become extremely sophisticated with contra-rotating propellers and more. Flying them
