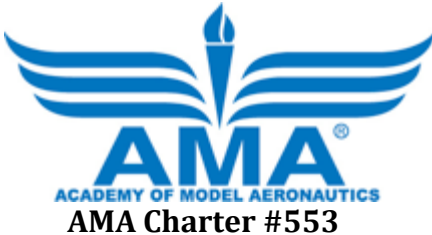

Minutes from Meeting #608 held on October 26, 2015 at Circleville Methodist Church:

- President Ray Hurley called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM and the pledge of allegiance was given.
- There were 18 voting members in attendance.
- The minutes from the previous meeting were approved as printed in the newsletter.
- The Treasurer's Report was given and approved.
- The club's bills were read and were approved to be paid.

Communications:

- Jerry has ordered and received 500 KCRC business cards and will be distributed to the membership
- A letter from Chevron showing a change in contact address was read and will be given to the secretary for future reference.
- A letter from the IRS was received directing the club e-file and will be kept on file for tax purposes.

Field Report:

- Eric Haberman reported that the field looks good and there will be a field closing work party October 31st at 9:00 A.M.
- The port-o-john has been returned for 2015 and no longer available at the field.
- The mowers will not be serviced at Labuda this fall .

Old Business:

- • Road project waiting on millings from the state.
- Bo and Ron reported on the pavilion project and aside from some soffit ends, some reinforcements, gutters and landscaping the project is done for this year. The remainder of work is to be completed in the spring 2016.
- Safety Barrier committee (Bill Pilesi, Rich Kucera, Dave Popovic) have all the materials and are waiting for pavilion project to be completed and will be done spring 2016.
- A windsock will be installed permanently at the end of the sun shade spring of 2016
- There was no response to the e-mail from the nominating committee for prospective candidates of the office for secretary and treasurer. Michelle Kwasney was nominated for secretary on the basis that she has been a member for three years, but as a spousal member. Michelle will also do the newsletter providing she can get a template format. This was agreed by the membership to qualify for the position according to the by-laws. Bo Kawsney threw his hat in the ring for the position of treasurer. There were no other nominations for any offices.
- Mike Stack will be contacted as to the sign on Mars Hill at Oggs Lane.
- The Christmas Party will be on December 4th at K-Vays from 6-9 P.M. Please let Michelle or Mike know if you will be attending by Nov. 20 so we can have a good head count. Those members that sold tickets for the raffle will be paid for by the club. Guests and non-ticket sellers are invited at \$20.00 a person. All funds should be sent to the P.O. Box. There will be gifts for the ladies and variety of prizes has and will be purchased. Donations for prizes will be accepted by contacting Mike Shephard. \$500 was voted on and approved for purchase of prizes etc. for the party.

New Business:

- Quote from Rick Paul was made to clear trees from the picnic area for approx. \$1500 and was tabled until spring 2016
- Mention was made to move the existing windsock and will be evaluated spring of 2016.
- Dues for 2016 are \$75.00 and due between Oct 31 and Dec. 31 2015 or a \$25.00 fee will be added to the individual dues as per the by-laws. A spouse may be added as an associate member for \$1.00. Members under age of 19 are non-voting members and their dues are free aligning with AMA structure. This was approved by vote by the membership.
- A vote was made for the incentive reimbursement as follows: \$6.00 per man per grass cutting session. \$3.00 /hr. per man for work party participation and was passed by the membership.
- Vote was made and passed that Bo Kwasney and Ron Steban receive 5 years membership for compensation and appreciation of their work on the pavilion.
- Mention was made to attach backs to the sun shades for added shade and will be accomplished spring 2016.
- Vote was made and approved to retain the accountants for 2016 for tax statements and accounting purposes.
- Any club project ideas should be bought up as soon as possible for planning 2016
- It was mentioned by Dan that it would be nice to have a center line painted on the field and this will be evaluated and/or done spring 2016

- Meeting adjourned at 8:05 P.M.
